Steve's 35-year career with the USGS included helping develop the publication "Putting Down Roots in Earthquake Country: Your Handbook for the San Francisco Bay Area." He lives in Menlo Park and has taken the CERT training.

Why Seismologists think the next Big Bay Area Earthquake Is Overdue

Steve will explain the science behind the USGS findings for regular quakes on the southern Hayward fault. The last six quakes (in 1134, 1317, 1475, 1629, 1725, and 1868) occurred at intervals of 95 to 183 years. The 1868 quake had an estimated magnitude of between 6.8-7.0.
